ny home, whether grand or understated needs to tell a story. For a young couple with a new home and a

story to tell, it was a six-month collaboration with interior design maven Greg Natale that would see their story brought home.

For any interior designer, recognising a starting point is vital and for Greg, it was the couple's retro art collection.

"If you look at the living room, everything you see compliments the David Bowie portrait," Greg says.

Throughout the 70s oversized furniture, luxurious materials and wallpapered ceilings were all the rage. Channeling those trends, a large tufted sofa and oversized wingback chairs evoke a look that screams 70s modern luxury.

But it's the wallpaper that really transcends the room from incredible to cutting edge, delivering a look that commands attention.

In the casual living area, Greg took inspiration from the Warhol 'Marilyn' print, choosing a Platner dining table reminiscent of 60s modernism. In the TV area, the broody 'Marilyn' colour palette carries over to the rug, perfectly complimenting the room's clean lines.

In the bedrooms a softer look dominates. The main bedroom showcases varying shades of lilac that contrasts comfortably with the modern black and white carpet, denoting perfect
