





THE BRIEF: For the study in their new Sydney home, which has a predominantly black-and-white palette, the owners asked interior designer Greg Natale for a room that would radiate sunshine. And, as with the rest of the house, it had to have an individual touch.

WHY IT WORKS: Yellow walls and vibrant silk curtains create a burst of warmth, echoed by the gold sheen in the light fitting, with its strong element of fantasy, as well as the mirror and various ornaments. Meanwhile, the black of the lampshade and the cushion provides a deep counterpoint and grounds the room. Retro furnishings and accessories by Jonathan Adler are elegant and stylish, but with a touch of whimsy. These include the desk chair, sunburst mirror and ornamental dogs.
